The Colorado Weed Management Association (CWMA) is offering professional development grants to support members interested in attending the CWMA Winter Training or Spring Training.

Guidelines

Grants are available for CWMA members to receive free registration to the CWMA Winter or Spring Training School, who would not have opportunity to attend otherwise. Four registrations will be available to CWMA members that can demonstrate need for the grant.

Eligibility

An applicant must have a current CWMA membership. Please confirm your membership status with staff before submitting your application. Applicant must not have previously received a CWMA professional development grant. Funds requested must be used in the calendar year in which they were awarded. Applicant must demonstrate need in application.

Selection Criteria:

The applicant must explain why the grant is needed to support training attendance and document any matching funds available. Recipient agrees to allow CWMA to announce award on website or in other promotional materials. Recipient will be asked for a photo of themselves attending the training for which the grant has been awarded.

Application Process

Applications for Spring Training are due by the last day in February; applications for Winter Training are due by the last day in September. Submit the application form below to info@cwma.org no later than 11:59pm (Mountain)
