

Technician Training Frequently Asked Questions

Who should take the technician training courses?

These courses are designed to satisfy the training requirements for unlicensed technicians who do not hold a license. It can also be used as a study guide for Certified Operator or Qualified Supervisor testing.

Does this course provide any credits?

This course does not provide any credits for pesticide applicator licenses. Our Winter and Springs trainings are for continuing education credits, as well as our webinars.

What do the technician training courses cover?

These training courses cover the categories required by the technician training verification form from the Colorado Department of Ag. These categories include: public and applicator safety, pesticide use, host and pest ID, environmental protection, pest management, pesticides and their families, laws and regulations, and pesticide labelling.

Is this course just for weed management?

The technician training courses are geared towards all pesticide applicators and there are host and pest ID sections that cover: terrestrial weeds, outdoor vertebrate, and aquatic species.
